Our form and how we do things is changing. The form changes, but the essence or substance stays the same – which is Christ. In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. This is the Logos. In scripture, Hebrews 1 tells us that everything holds together by the power of His Word. Everything from the sun, the moon, and stars to the clouds in the sky, the mountains, rivers, and fields, to the cells in our body is held together by the power of the Logos – the Living Word, Jesus. Connect with the Logos. The blueprint of what is being formed in this time is in the Logos. Logos can be translated as 'blueprint or the message'. God is releasing blueprints to build with – listen to the Word God is speaking. In the Word is your blueprint and the blueprint for our City.

Warfare forms in the gap between destiny and identity. Know that warfare is confined. The Logos is your weapon; what God has spoken already rules and reigns over your life and family. Your identity is as a Son of God. Christ in you is your identity. You are a new creation and all things in you have been made new. Your identity is in Christ. Destiny is God's plan and purpose for your life. Destiny is a force; it creates energy and vision for you to advance into the fullness of your identity. Identity is the core of your being. Let the force of your identity and destiny overcome the place of warfare – the place where the devil tells lies about who you are. What God speaks over you is your place of victory. Greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world opposing you. Something small, like the devil, can't govern over what God has spoken. God spoke your identity and purpose into you – this is the Logos. The power of what God has spoken into you cannot be overcome by the devil.
