Holiness Is the Womb of the Future November 11, 2025 Suzi Armstrong

God is calling us into the holiness of His presence and to worship Him because He is holy. There is a powerful anointing that we have been experiencing as we cry holy, holy, holy is the Lord. In His holiness is His power and might. The Book of Exodus records that when God's holiness came there was thunder and lightning; a thick cloud came and covered the area. There was fire and smoke and the ground shook while the whole mountain quaked violently. The holiness of God is a demonstration of His sovereignty and His majesty. We respond to His holiness with worship. There are no words that can describe the awe and wonder of His holy presence.

Holy means set apart. God is set apart from everything. Creation belongs to Him – the earth is His and everything in it. I had a dream Saturday night where Holy Spirit showed me that that holiness was like the womb that held the future. There were things that God was birthing inside of holiness – it could not come into place outside of holiness. What is being birthed is connected to the future – to the new era. There are things being birthed that are for our City, for us, and for our families and communities. The seed for the future and elements of the future are inside of the realm of God's holiness. Our access is through the holiness of Christ in us. We are holy because He is holy.

Isaiah 6.1-8, 13 NIV

¹ In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple. ² Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. ³ And they were calling to one another:

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory."

⁴ At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke.

⁵ "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For **I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips**, and my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty."

⁶ Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. ⁷ With it he touched my mouth and said, **"See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for."**

⁸ Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?"

And I said, **"Here am I. Send me!"**

¹³ And though a tenth remains in the land, it will again be laid waste.

But as the terebinth and oak leave stumps when they are cut down,

so the holy seed will be the stump in the land."

- The stump is a type of womb that carries the future during a time of judgment.
- Carrying God's promises, the seed and blueprints of the future.

Isaiah 11.1-3a NIV

¹ **A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit.**

² The **Spirit of the Lord** will rest on him—the **Spirit of wisdom and of understanding**, the **Spirit of counsel and of might**, the **Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the Lord**—

³ and he will delight in the fear of the Lord.

- God promised David, "I will raise up your offspring after you...and I will establish the throne of His kingdom forever."
- This promise was kept in the womb of the future – the holy seed was in the stump of Jesse.

Psalm 139.13 NIV

¹³ For you created my inmost being; **you knit me together in my mother's womb.**

- The womb is a holy place where the Creator acts directly.

Psalm 22.10b NASB

You have been my God from my mother's womb.

Psalm 110.3 KJV

³ **Thy people shall be willing in the day of thy power, in the beauties of holiness from the womb of the morning: thou hast the dew of thy youth.**

- The womb of the morning refers to dawn – the breaking of a new day, a new time. A place of freshness, the dew is still wet. A new order will come into place.
- The womb that contains the new day – the place of promise; a prophetic place is inside of holiness.
 - The womb shelters, protects, and nurtures. It is a place of purity and cleanness.
 - It is a dimension of the compassion and sovereignty of God.

Acts 2.2-4, 11b-12 NIV

² **Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled** the whole house where they were sitting. ³ They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. ⁴ **All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.**

...we hear them declaring the wonders of God in our own tongues!" ¹² Amazed and perplexed, they asked one another, "What does this mean?"

- The Spirit of Holiness had entered the hearts of men.
- Seeing the demonstration of holiness in those who received the Holy Spirit left others utterly amazed and perplexed. Something holy had been birthed and it defined a new era.

Acts 3.4-8a NIV

⁴ Peter looked straight at him, as did John. Then Peter said, "Look at us!" ⁵ So the man gave them his attention, expecting to get something from them.

⁶ Then Peter said, **"Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk."** ⁷ **Taking him by the right hand, he helped him up, and instantly the man's feet and ankles became strong.** ⁸ **He jumped to his feet and began to walk.**

- Peter and John did not have silver or gold – they were not giving to the man out of the world's supply.
- Peter and John were born again, not of perishable seed, but the imperishable seed of Jesus – a holy seed, pure and righteous. Healing is a demonstration of holiness.
- A branch came from the stump of Jesse and bore fruit.

The power of holiness is bringing us into alignment with Almighty God for this time. We hear His voice more clearly. The fear of the Lord is resident in our hearts. The sound of holiness in us makes way for His sheer power to saturate us. We are carriers of His holy presence and wherever we walk we carry the power of His holy presence into that place, into the environment, just like Jesus did and Peter and John.

PRAYER AND DECLARATION:

Like Peter and John said to the lame man at the Gate Beautiful, we say to Detroit, silver and gold we do not have, but what we do have we give to you. In the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk into the future that God designed for you. We take you, Detroit, by the right hand and help you out of the pit, out of the muck and mire of what cripples you. We prophesy over you, "Jump to your feet and begin to walk in your identity, gifts and calling for this time". Your ankles will become strong, you will stand and take your place, and the nations will be utterly amazed! **Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty!**
