Behold! God's Wisdom Is Being Made Visible! June 10, 2025 Suzi Armstrong

Matthew 11.19b TPT

...God's wisdom will become visible by those who embrace it."

- The Lord is releasing expansion in our hearts and in our minds to see. Boundaries have shifted. We are in a time of expansion.
- Willingness, openness, hunger, and desire activate the eyes of our spirit knowing that there is more that you have not seen or experienced or embraced. There are mysteries of God being revealed.
- God's wisdom is in this. Look to see.
- Behold! All things are made new.

'Behold' is defined as:

- To see or perceive.
- Discern.
- Discover and learn something new.
- Turn your attention to.
- Point something out.
- To see and have revelation.
- By implication, what you behold is regarded as important. Be alert!

When you behold something, it stands out to you. What you are looking at is not part of the landscape, but it stands out and gets your attention. When you behold something, you stop or pause to take in what you are seeing. It catches your eye and demands your scrutiny.

This is a time that the Lord is saying to us, "Behold! Stop and look and take in what I am saying and doing. There is new meaning and understanding that I am revealing. I will give you wisdom."

Isaiah 54.2-4 TPT

² "Increase is coming, so enlarge your tent and add extensions to your dwelling. Hold nothing back! Make the tent ropes longer and the pegs stronger.

³ You will increase and spread out in every direction.

Your sons and daughters will conquer nations and revitalize desolate cities.

⁴ Do not fear, for your shame is no more.

Do not be embarrassed, for you will not be disgraced.

You will forget the inadequacy you felt in your youth

and will no longer remember the shame of your widowhood."

⁴ Pilate came out again and said to them, **"Behold, I am bringing Him out to you so that you may know that I find no guilt in Him."** ⁵ Jesus then came out, wearing the crown of thorns and the purple robe. Pilate said to them, **"Behold, the Man!"** ⁶ So when the chief priests and the officers saw Him, they cried out saying, "Crucify, crucify!"

¹⁵ So they cried out, "Away with Him, away with Him, crucify Him!" Pilate said to them, "Shall I crucify your King?" The chief priests answered, "We have no king but Caesar."

- Pilate said, behold look at this man Jesus. There is no guilt in Him.
- Immediately the chief priests and officers shouted out "crucify". The voice of the religious spirit comes to bring condemnation, and confusion to control, and manipulation for personal gain. Trying to instill fear in the hearts of the people to shut them down.
- The Jews aligned with civil government rather than the government of God. This is an ultimate connection between the political spirit and the religious spirit. The government of God was rejected in favor of the government of man.
 - The Jews did this in the OT, when they cried out for a visible physical man to be their king instead of God who was invisible.
