- God is the initiator.

- Paul prays for the Father to pour out on the believers in Ephesus the ability to know Him more and to know Him in a deeper way.
 - o We can want to know God, but He is the one who reveals Himself.
 - God Himself must give us access to know Him we can't know Him without Him enabling
 us to know Him.
- Wisdom and revelation are insight and understanding given to us by God so that we can KNOW Him. We can then connect to Him with greater clarity.
- This opens the door to deeper understanding and deeper relationship.
- Holy Spirit leads us into greater truth through revelation knowledge of God.
- There are portals that God has opened so that we can see Him and know Him in ways that we have not known Him before.
- With each God encounter there is new and deeper knowing Him and knowing the mind of Christ.

 - Through revelation knowledge the stronghold over a city can be pulled down.
 - We declare over Detroit that the stronghold of the enemy will be pulled down and God's presence and the sound of heaven will resound from this city!

 - An exploit is a heroic act; a deed of renown; a great or noble achievement; a great act that extends righteousness.
 - Exploits will be performed through people who KNOW (through extensive revelation knowledge) their God.
