Confident: the feeling or belief that one can rely on someone, firm trust.
Synonyms: certainty, faith, conviction.

Trust: firm belief in the reliability, truth, ability or strength of someone.
Synonyms: confidence, belief, faith, assurance, certitude.



As we can see they are similar in meaning. Holy Spirit said it's like saying: Behold! Take heed! Listen! Look again! Pay close attention to!

Philippians 1.6 NASB

⁶For I am CONFIDENT of this very thing, that He (GOD) who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.

What "very thing" are we to be confident of? In those things God has told us will be; truly shall be (not a might or a maybe).

Psalms 138.8 TPT

⁸You (GOD) keep every promise you've ever made to me! Since your love for me is constant and endless, I ask you, Lord, to finish every good thing that you've begun in me.

Proverbs 3.5-6 TPT

⁵TRUST in the Lord completely, and do not rely on your own opinions (wisdom). With all your heart rely on Him to guide you, and He will lead you in every decision you make.
⁶Become intimate with Him in whatever you do, and He will lead you wherever you go.

Jeremiah 17.7-8 NASB

⁷Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord
And who trust is the Lord.
⁸"For he will be like a tree planted by the water,
That extends its roots by a stream
And will not fear when the heat comes;
But its leaves will be green,
And it will not be anxious in a year of drought
Nor cease to yield fruit.

DECLARATION over DETROIT (from Isaiah 41.10 and 42.6):
